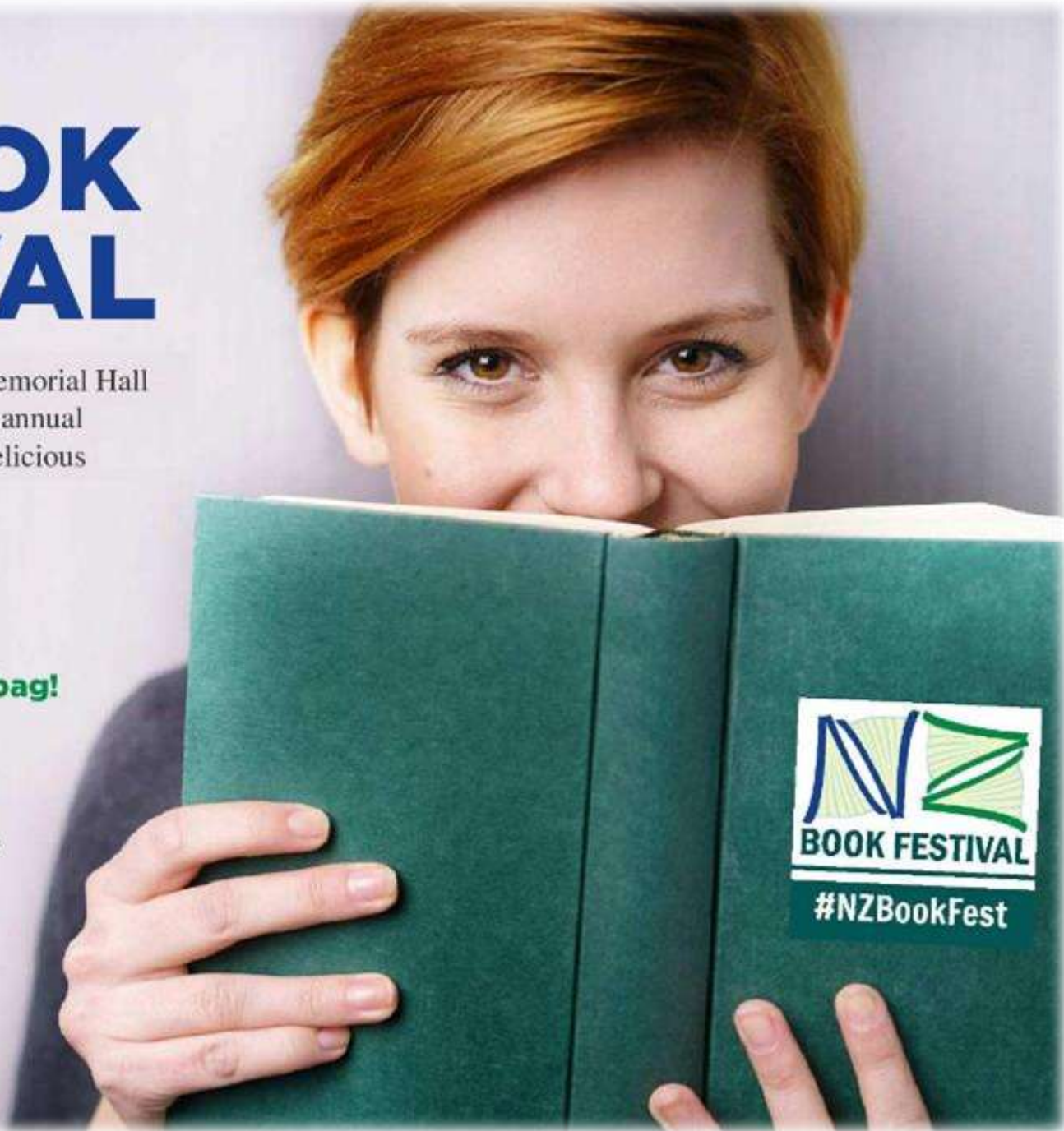
Come on down to Mt Eden War Memorial Hall on Saturday 17th November for the annual NZ Book Festival! There will be delicious food, great coffee and best of all?
