1941-1942
The first year of the war was a time of great hardship for the people of the United States. Many families were forced to live in bomb shelters and ration their food. The government also imposed strict rules on the economy to support the war effort.



1943-1944
The war continued to rage, and the United States played a major role in the Allied forces. The atomic bomb was dropped on Hiroshima in August 1945, leading to the end of the war in the Pacific. The war also led to the beginning of the Cold War between the United States and the Soviet Union.
